Hazel O. Reynolds passed away peacefully on March 30, 2013 at her residence in Northern Virginia.. She was 97 years old.

Mrs. Reynolds was born in Strongsville, Ohio February 1, 1916. She was the daughter of Jean C. and Ralph D. Graves. She was preceded in death by her three brothers and two sisters.

Mrs. Reynolds lived in Jamestown, Rhode Island for over 50 years before moving to Northern Virginia to live with her daughter.

She is survived by her daughters, Shirley J. Tuttle of West Linn, Oregon and her husband, Knight, Hazel A. Saffell of Hamilton, Virginia and her husband Charles. Mrs. Reynolds also is survived by 4 stepchildren; Carol Chase, of Jamestown, Judy Calabretta and her husband Vic of Jamestown, Douglas Reynolds and his wife Annie of Belchertown, Massachusetts, John Robert Reynolds and his wife, Beth of Barefoot, Florida, and step daughter in law Amber Reynolds of Chalmersford, Pennsylvania.
