Nicholas Gregory Gianourakos, 67 of Leesburg, VA passed away on Monday, January 27, 2014.

Nick was born Monday, January 27, 1947 in Boston, Massachusetts. He was the son of the late Michael Gianourakos and the late Pota Demas Gianourakos.

He served his country in the US Army during the Vietnam Era.

He was a graduate of Northeastern University in Boston (Accounting Major, Economics Minor) received his Master's from the University of South Carolina, and is an ABD (All but Dissertation) with the University of Virginia.

He was a tax executive with H& R Block of Leesburg for over 30 years.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 40+ years, Marcie Boucouvalas of Leesburg, and daughter, Anastasia "Stacie" Boucouvalas-Gianourakos of Arlington, MA, plus many other family members and friends in Virginia and Boston who will dearly miss him.

The family will receive friends from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM on Monday, February 3, 2014, at Loudoun Funeral Chapel, 158 Catocin Circle, SE, Leesburg, Virginia.

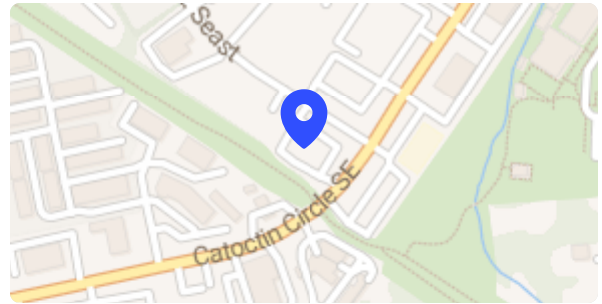

I understand he had another life in Leesburg for 33 years, and part of me is jealous that so many of his local friends had him to themselves while I lived elsewhere. He was a warm, uncomplicated, selfless soul, who would do anything he could, and then some, for those he loved. 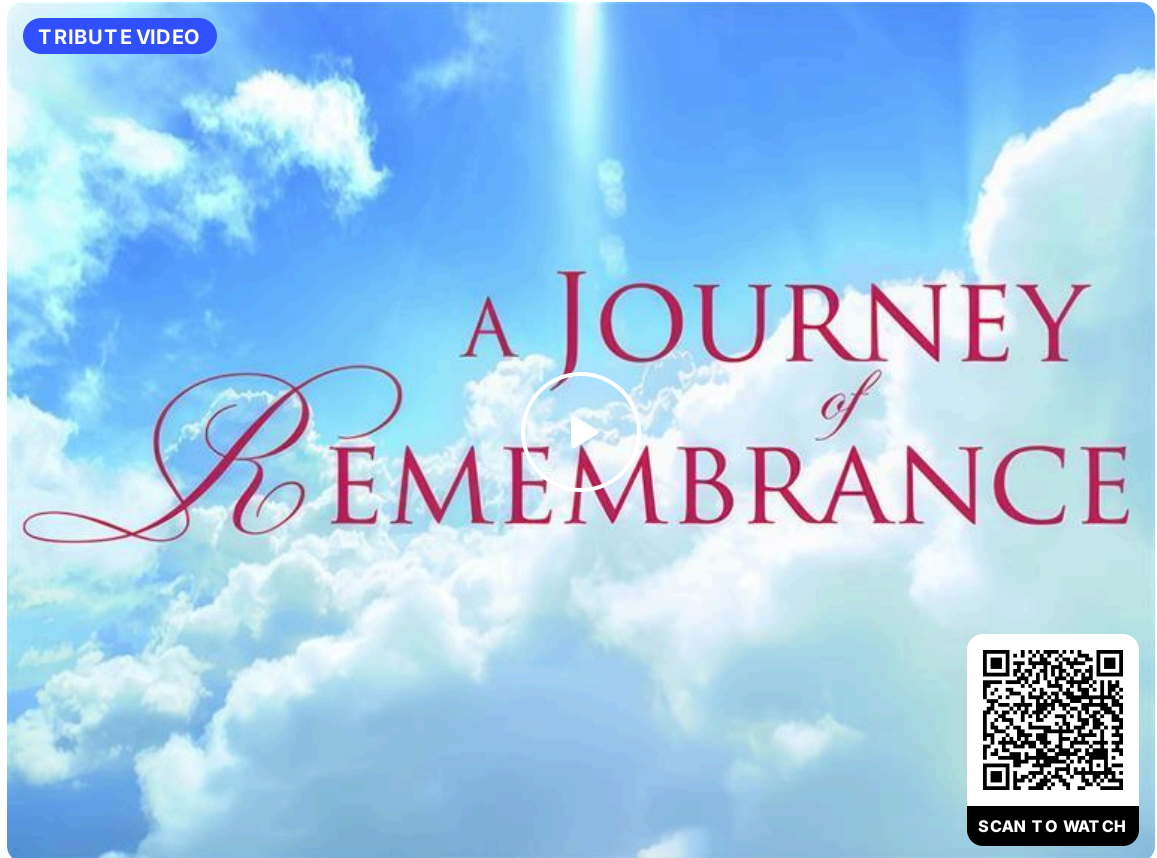
