Wayde R. York, 56, of Leesburg, VA, passed away on Tuesday, August 12, 2014 at Loudoun Hospital.

Born on October 25, 1957 in Washington DC he was the son of the late Wade C. York and the late Christine Ann Prescimone York. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his brother, Gary York.

Upon graduation from high school, Wayde spent three years serving his country in the Army. He was a graduate of the University of Phoenix and most recently was a security engineer for Creative Computing Solutions, Inc. 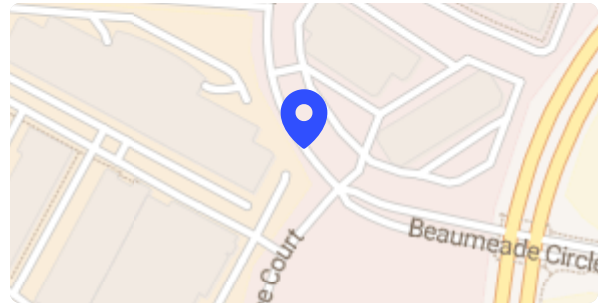
