JANE ELLIOTT DAVIS GRANT, ARTIST AND POET DIED AT AGE 91 IN PURCELLVILLE, VIRGINIA

Mrs. Grant, formally of Columbus, Ohio, was the daughter of J. Boyd & Elizabeth Davis. She married Jack Ellis Grant of Grandview, Ohio in 1939.

Jane & Jack Grant were long time residents of Washington, D.C.. Mrs. Grant was a graduate of Ohio State University of Fine Arts, member of the DAR, Huguenot Society of London, Colonial Dames of the 17th Century, Metropolitan United Methodist Church, and the AAUW.

Her three children survive her: William Davis Grant, Jane Elliott Grant Taylor, and Jacquelin Sue Grant; five grandchildren and four great grandchildren.
