**M**ARGUERITE C. SHINE “BUNNY”, 82, on Friday, August 25, 2006 in Fairfax, Virginia.

Mrs. Shine was born January 12, 1924, in Boston, Massachusetts, to the late Martin Caulfield and the late Margaret Caulfield Shaughnessy. Mrs. Shine was an active member of the United States Navy Officers Wives Club while she was married to CAPT John Sweeny, USN.
