Commodore Ramon Perez Madrid, Armed Forces of the Philippines (MNSA) 80, of Hamilton, VA, died Tuesday, October 31, 2006, at Loudoun Hospital Center/ Cornwall Unit in Leesburg, VA. Born on August 31, 1926 in Manila, Philippines. He was the son of the late Jose D. Madrid and the late Visitacion Perez Madrid.
