George Bernard Schmith, Jr., of Hernando, FL formerly of Leesburg, VA died June 12, 2008 at Capital Hospice in Arlington, VA. Born on March 13, 1940, in Washington, DC, a son of George Bernard Schmith, Sr. of Plantation, FL and the late Ellen May Gill Schmith. He was also predeceased by his grandson George Garrett Carrales.

George, also known as Bernie to his family and classmates, graduated from McLean High School in 1958. He went on to serve his country in the United States Air Force. He was stationed in Albany, GA where he met and married his wife Darnell Davis Schmith in 1961. Mr. Schmith worked for the Washington Star for 14 years before going to work for the Washington Post in 1977. He retired from the Washington Post as the Circulation Zone Manager after completing twenty-five years of employment. His hobbies included golf, hunting, and fishing.
