JAMES LEWIS PRATT, 72, formerly of Preston County, West Virginia before moving to Lucketts, Virginia in 1961, died peacefully with his family by his side in Leesburg, Virginia on Thursday June 19, 2008. He was born July 25, 1935 in Tunnelton, West Virginia to the late Homer R. and Genevieve Pyles Pratt. Three children and two brothers also predeceased him. Mr. Pratt was a member of the local 1590 union and worked in the construction field as a carpenter supervisor up until his retirement in 1995.
