**W**illiam Kenton Schuble, Jr., 75, Deerfield Beach, Florida and Leesburg, Virginia died Monday October 5, 2009 in Leesburg. He was born September 6, 1934 in Chicago, IL to the late William Kenton Schuble, Sr. and the late Jeanette Magliano Schuble. Mr. Schuble owned and operated WKS Contractors and Engineers, Inc. in Rockville, MD for 17 years. He enjoyed captaining his boat, the Persephone, on the Chesapeake Bay, but his true passion was fly-fishing in Virginia, Florida and Montana. Mr. Schuble was also an avid big game hunter around the world at destinations including Botswana, South Africa, British Columbia, Mexico and the Rocky Mountains.

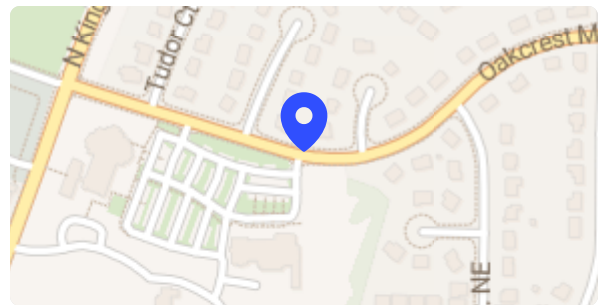
