Mrs. Barbara Lucille Lawson, 76, of Lucketts, VA, died Monday, November 9, 2009, at INOVA Loudoun Hospital Center in Lansdowne, VA.

Born on April 9, 1933, one of eleven children, Barbara was the daughter of the late Noah Edwards Garfield Aker and the late Lila M. Porter Aker.

Mrs. Lawson moved to Loudoun in the early 1950s and made Lucketts home.

She assisted her late husband Harry West "Buck" Lawson in the family well drilling business.

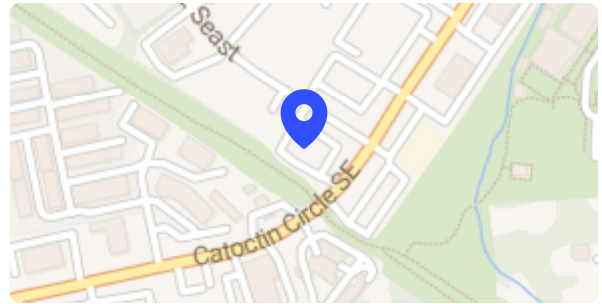

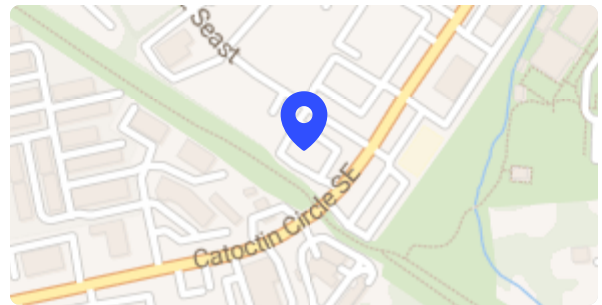

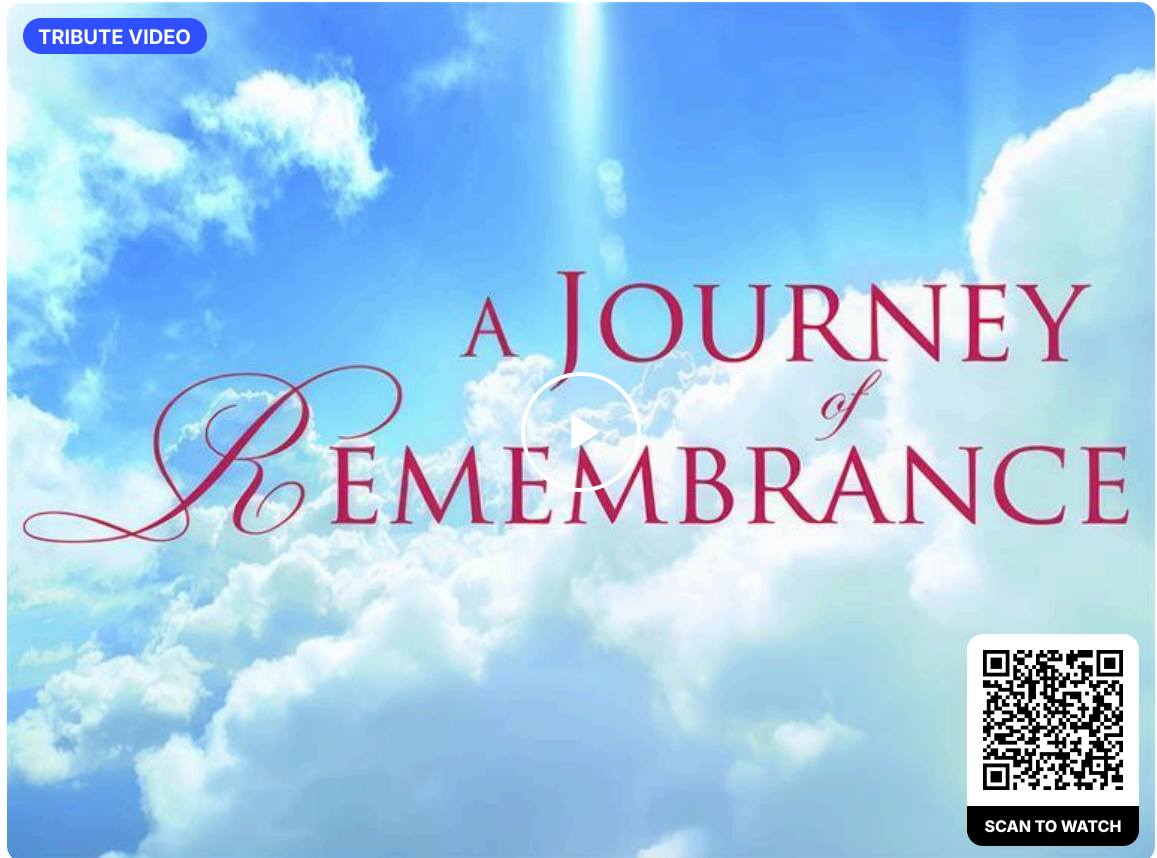
