ROSELIND M. DAVIS, 91, of Ashburn, VA, died on Saturday, December 19, 2009 in Arlington, VA. Mrs. Davis was born November 21, 1918 in Glendale, NY to the late Charles and Elizabeth Draiss Michel. She was preceded in death by her husband, Arthur R. Davis, and a daughter, Maureen E. Davis. Mrs. Davis lived in Chester, PA for 53 years before moving to the Wingler House, Ashburn, VA in 2000.

While in Chester, Mrs. Davis was active in her church and community, participating in the Church of the Resurrection of Our Lord's Women's Club, serving as Treasurer for many years, the Parish Council, and Catholic Daughters.
