Mr. Lawrence S. Murphy, "Larry" 80, of Leesburg, VA, died Tuesday, January 19, 2010, at Virginia Hospital Center.

Born on July 5, 1929 in Indianapolis, Indiana; he was a son of the late Lawrence Murphy and the late Thelma Jean Sering Murphy.

Larry was the Owner/Operator of the Sterling Exxon from 1966 to 1986. Later he worked for VA Ground Cover, formerly T.J. Crouch & Son as a heavy equipment operator.

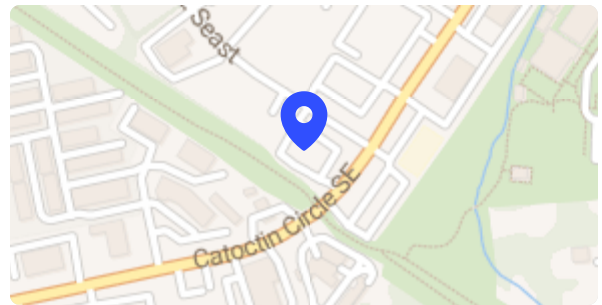
