Mass will be celebrated on Thursday, March 18 at 11 am at St. Theresa Catholic Church in Ashburn, VA.






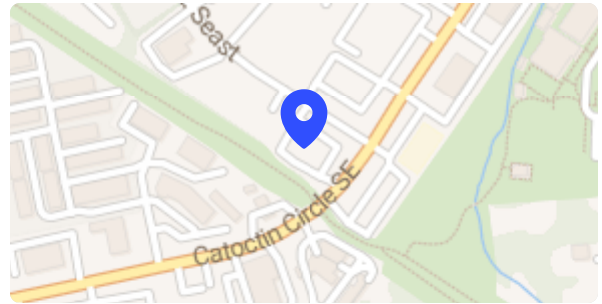

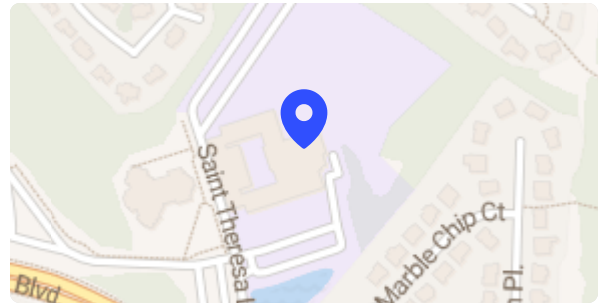
