OBITUARY INFORMATION

HARLAN HARVEY YOST, 88, of Sunrise Assisted Living in Sterling died on Monday January 31st 2011. Mr. Yost was born September 15th 1922 in Erie, PA to the late Harry A. and Evelyn Claire Biles Yost. His wife, Jean C. Dresser Yost also predeceased him. Mr. Yost served in the Army Air Corp during WWII in Guam and in the U.S. Air Force in Alamogordo, NM and WPAFB in Dayton, OH. He lived in California and worked in the Aerospace Industry from 1950 to 1990.

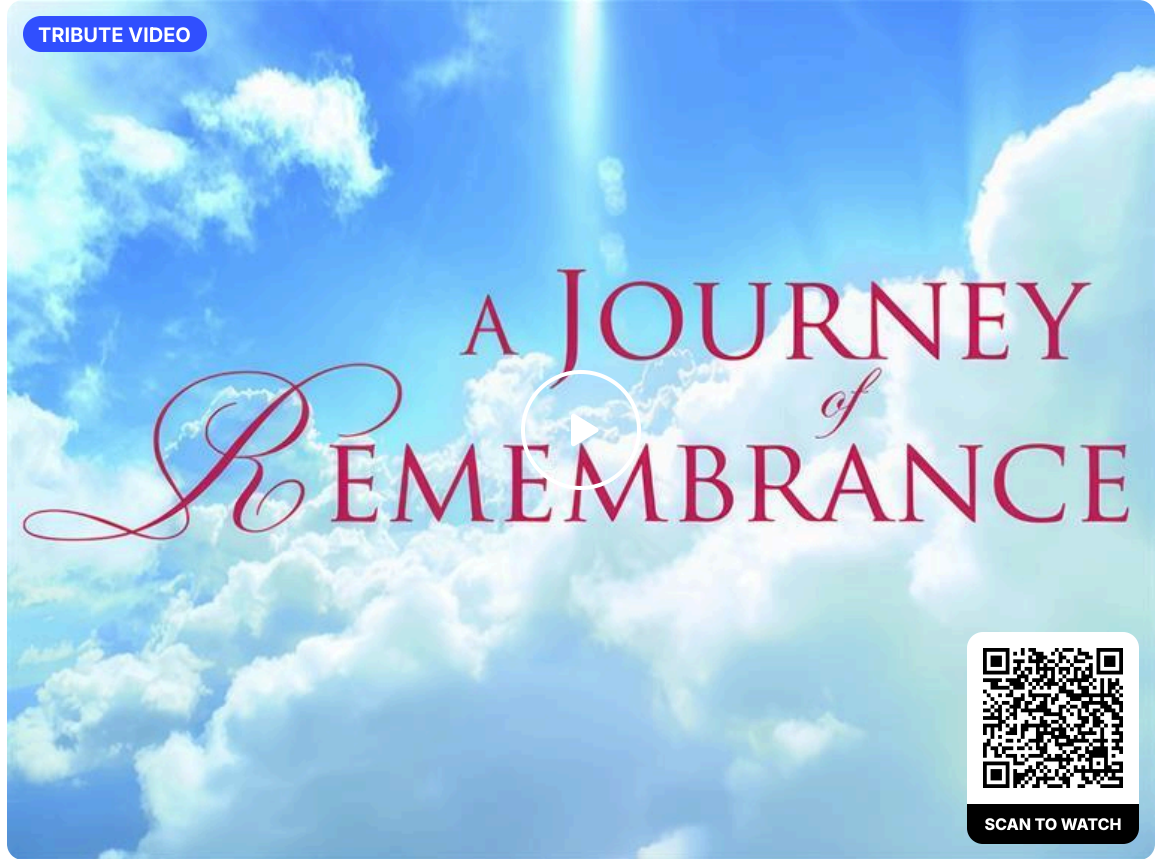
