J OAN GRAHAM, 52, Beloved wife, mother, daughter and grandmother of Leesburg, Virginia died at home on Sunday, March 27th 2011.

Mrs. Graham was born October 25th 1958 in Jacksonville, Fl. She was raised in Jacksonville and resided there until moving to Virginia in 2003.

Mrs. Graham was active in the Girl Scouts with her daughters for over 12 years. She was also active in Lads to Leaders and Leaderettes at the Lake Forest Church of Christ in Jacksonville and was instrumental in starting the leadership group at the Leesburg Church of Christ.

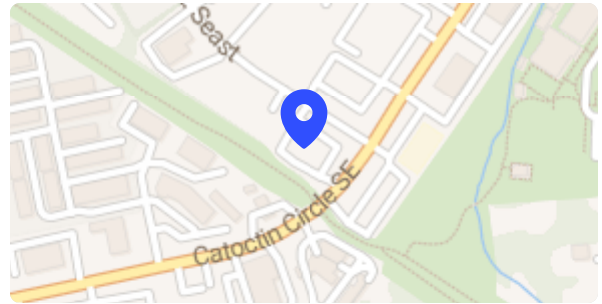

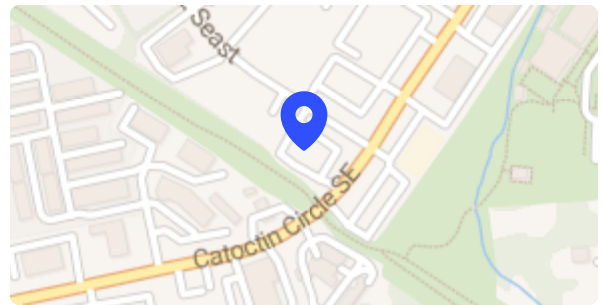
