**C**harleen A. Truax, 67, of Lansdowne, Virginia passed away on Monday, April 18, 2011.

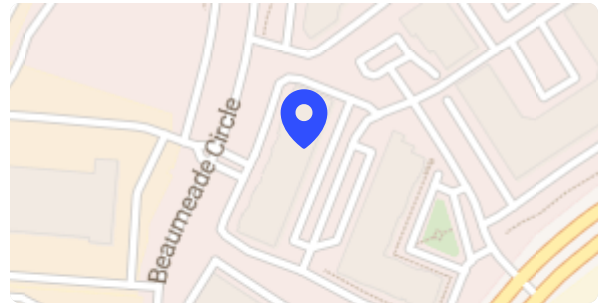
