BASIL WILLIAM MULLINS, 82, of Lucketts, Virginia died at home on Tuesday, September 6th 2011.

Mr. Mullins was born January 8th 1929 in Clendenin, West Virginia to the late Bud and Martha Salisbury Mullins. A son Richard Allen Mullins and a sister, Patricia Vistin also predeceased him.

He was a pipeline union welder with Pace Pipeline Company out of Pennsylvania. Mr. Mullins worked in numerous places with the union including Maryland, Pennsylvania and Alaska before retiring in 1992.

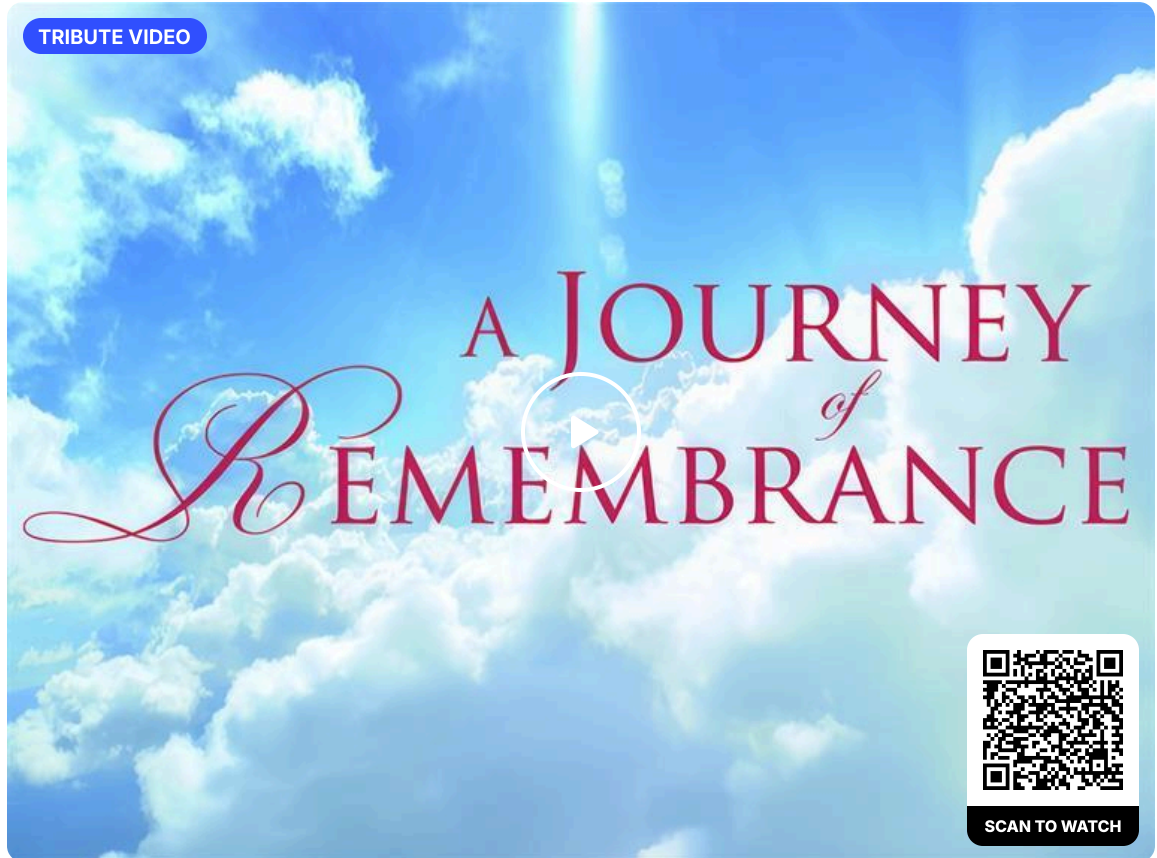
