## **Belva Graham Brady**

**B**elva Graham Brady, 79, a lifelong resident of Lovettsville, VA passed away on October 5th 2011 at Greenfield Assisted Living in Berryville, VA surrounded by her family.

Belva was born January 8th 1932 in Lovettsville to the late Fred and Bernice Brown Graham. Her husband, John E. Brady and a son-in-law, Lewis Thompson also predeceased her.

Belva attended elementary and high school in Lovettsville and later attended the Hagerstown Business School. She was a member of the New Jerusalem Lutheran Church where she had been a passionate member of the choir for many years. Belva had served on the Lovettsville Historical Society and over the years had worked at the practices of Drs. Joseph M. Rogers, Sam Morrison and David M. Mathis.

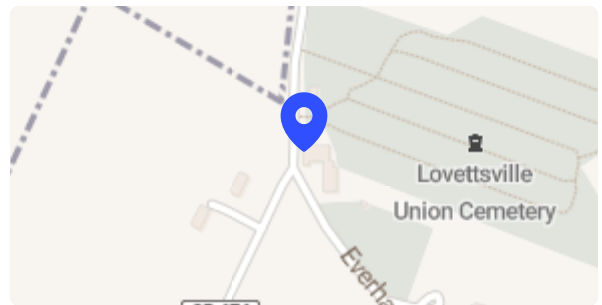
