Emory Mason Solomon, age 87 passed away on Monday, October 17, 2011 at his home in Ashburn, Virginia.

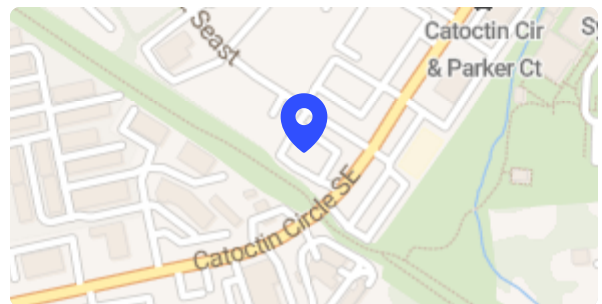

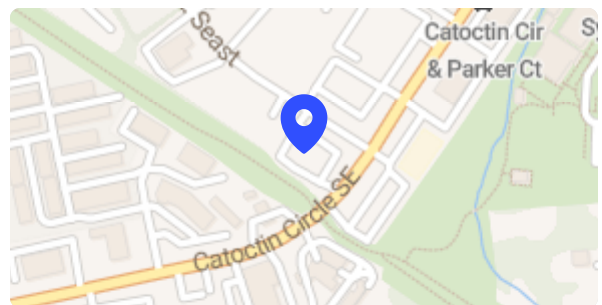
