## **O**BITUARY INFORMATION

ADDISON LEROY SAMPSON, SR., 74, of Aldie, Virginia since 1960 died on Tuesday, October 18th 2011 at his home. Mr. Sampson was born on December 25, 1936 to the late Richard E. and Betty M. Coates Sampson. He grew up in Falls Church, VA and graduated from Luther Jackson High School. After furthering his education at St. Paul's College in Lawrenceville, VA he pursued a career with the U.S. Postal Service. He served as a letter carrier for over 30 years at the Mosby Branch in Falls Church, and he retired in 1991. Since his retirement he has been working with Whitener and Jackson Construction.

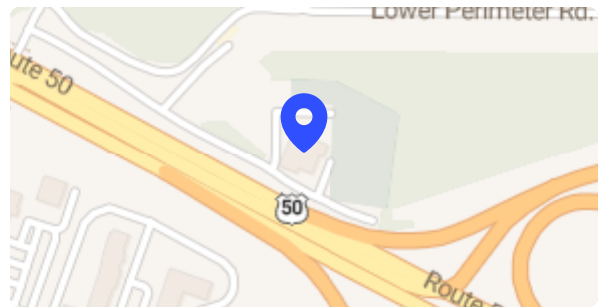
