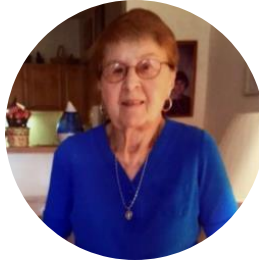

Ann M. Feconda, 95, of Lansdowne, Virginia, formerly of Springfield IL, Harrisburg PA, Washington PA and Canonsburg PA died peacefully at 2:28 p.m., on March 19, 2016, at Oak Terrace HealthCare Center in Springfield, Illinois.

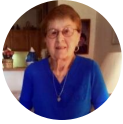
Ann was born on June 19, 1920 in Canonsburg, Pennsylvania, the daughter of Frank and Julianna Fetcko. She was the only daughter along with eight brothers all of whom preceded her in death. She married Joseph A. Feconda on December 23, 1943 and he preceded her in death on January 8, 2006. She was also preceded in death by a daughter, Marilyn F. Catalano on March 26, 1990.
