Oneida Peri Cioffi of Ashburn, Va., passed away on Thursday, June 23, 2016 at INOVA Loudoun Hospital at the age of 73 after a very short, but courageous bout with lung cancer.

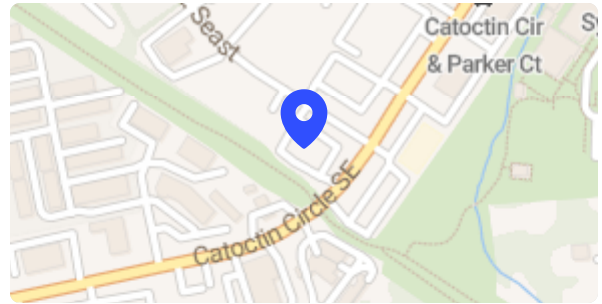

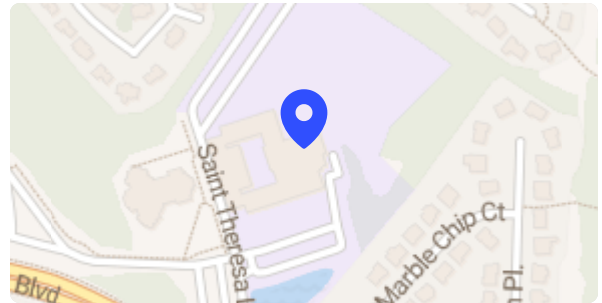
