DAVID KEMPER ASHLEY, 94, of Sterling, Virginia since 2006, formerly of South Charleston, WV, passed away on Friday, March 09, 2012 in Leesburg, Virginia.

Mr. Ashley was born March 24, 1917 in Corton, West Virginia to the late Rice McGhee and Emma Smith Ashley. His wife, Elizabeth F. Ashley predeceased him in August 2006.

Mr. Ashley served his country in the Army Air Corp during WWII from 1941-1944. He worked with Owens-Illinois in Kanawha City and Fairmont, WV before retiring in the 1970's.

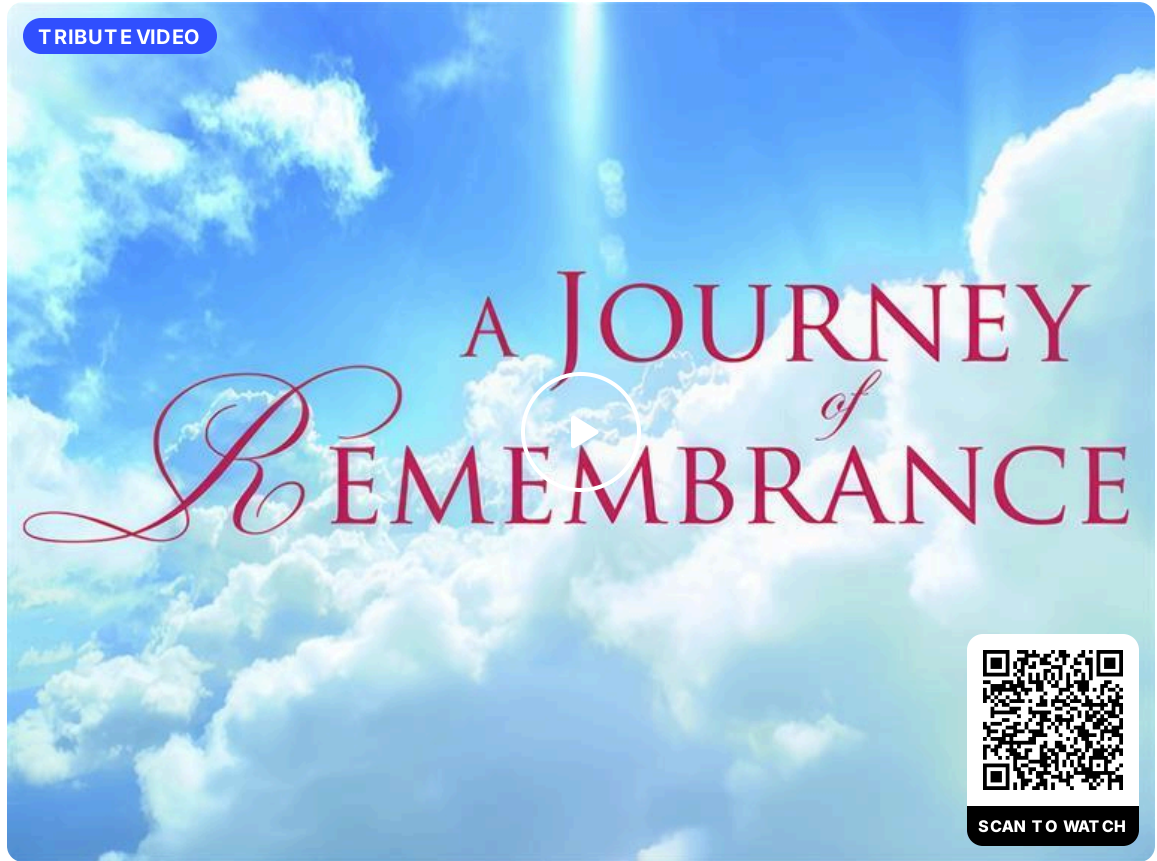
