Mary “Pauline” Weiskircher, age 92, passed away Tuesday January 3, 2017, at her long-time home in Leesburg, Virginia. She was born June 30, 1924 to Walter Lee and Sena Hash Jones in Grant, Virginia. It was there that she grew up with her brothers, Kyle and Clarence Jones, before relocating to Bel Air, MD. In Bel Air, she met and married the love of her life, Sylvester John Weiskircher. Pauline and Sylvester moved to Steubenville, Ohio, shortly after, to help run the family dairy business. In Ohio, Pauline and her husband were active members of St. Peter’s Catholic Church where they made many lifelong friends. 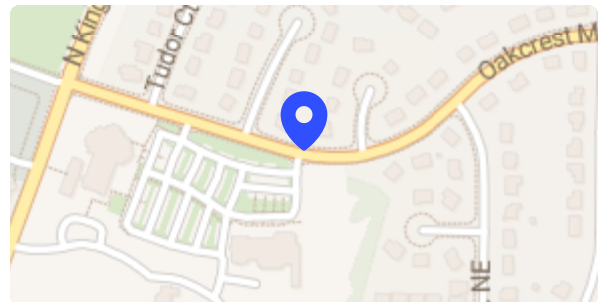

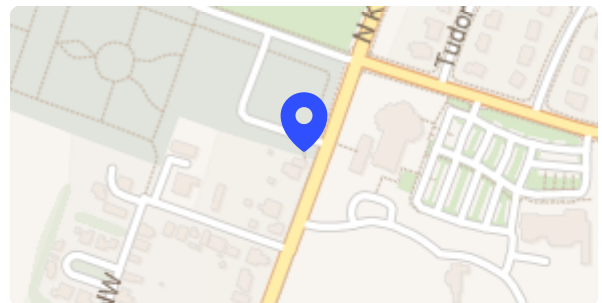
