Paul Roger Simons, Jr., 79, of Sterling, VA, passed away Wednesday, March 22, 2017, at his home in Sterling, VA.

He is the son of the late Paul Roger and Nellie (Tinney) Simons

Roger served in the United States Air Force, prior to his position as a mail carrier for the United States Postal Service for 27 years, from which he retired. In the 1990s, he and his son, Brett, owned and operated B&R Sportscards in Sterling. Roger coached little league soccer, was an avid sports memorabilia collector, loved the Washington Redskins and was a West Virginia Mountaineer Sports enthusiast.

He is survived by his wife: Patricia Ann (McCloud) Simons, daughter Traci (Carlos) Simons Infante of Sterling, son Brett Simons (fiancé Kathryn Henderson) of Herndon two granddaughters: Gabriela Grace de la Cruz and Gracie Ann Infante, sister Nancy (Jorge) Simons Sanchez, two brothers: Frank (Patty) Simons and Earnest (Cherie) "Ernie" Simons and several nieces and nephews.

Roger was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers: Mark and Larry Simons and a sister Shirley Valle.

A memorial service will be held on Sunday April 2, 2017 2:00PM at Loudoun Funeral Chapel, 158 Catoctin Cr. SE, Leesburg, VA. A visitation will be held from 1:00PM till the time of the services. Chaplain John Boyle will be officiating.

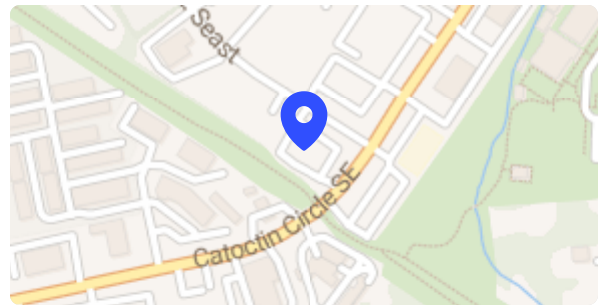

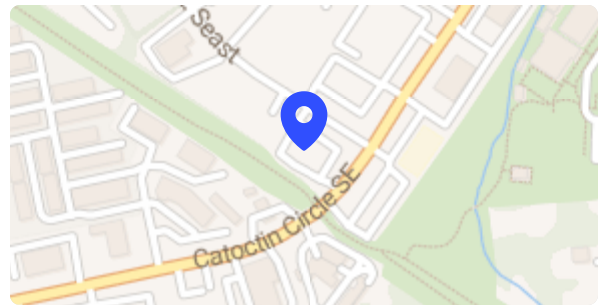

You were the best dad ever...- How many dads can fashion a makeshift potty chair out of an old US Mail tub for their little girl who won't "go" in the woods because the grass might tickle her butt? There was even a branch that served as a toilet paper dispenser.- Your sick behind the back 3 point shot that was always the move that you pulled out if you thought we were trailing too closely in a game of H.O.R.S.E- You took me and my friends to malls in different counties just so we had Champion outfits in colors that nobody else would have.- You were my biggest fan. You NEVER EVER missed a soccer, softball or basketball game. If you weren't coaching, assisting, base coaching or spectating, you were watching from the parking lot with your binoculars because you had been ejected.- You waited in line at Best until 1 am just so I could have my first Cabbage Patch Kid, Tonya Loretta, on Christmas morning...eventually I had 26 CPK's, including 2 sets of twins (one was preemies).- You painted every house that I ever lived in.- If I ever showed you any wooden outdoor furniture or planter box that I liked, you built it for me and it was always better than the original.- When I told you about my 5th grade project of creating something useful out of recycled material, you made "Electric Man" out of old metal scraps, used outlet and fuse boxes and he had a blue light bulb for a nose. My teacher was so impressed that she kept it for the rest of the year. All of the other kids has coat hangers sticking out of tin cans.- You treated all of my friends like they were part of our dysfunctional family.- You opened a sports card shop across the street from my middle school and made me one of the most popular girls of the entire school. I always had tons of offers from the boys to walk me home from school (thanks for that).- You had the best stories and could tell them for hours- You taught me how to be tough and told me that if a boy ever hit me, to hit them back or don't come home. You found this hysterical.- On our way home from soccer practice, we would pull up into random folks driveways and honk the horn until they came to the door and we would just waive and drive off.- You once saved my life when Brett knocked me unconscious during an extreme pillow fight and he brought my limp little body downstairs to you and you shook the crap out of me and lightly smacked my face until I came to. Then within 30 minutes you participated in the next round of extreme pillow fighting.- You taught me about me and I still share your characteristics of loyalty, having a good work ethic, and not taking sh*t from anyone- You put up with me...period- You practiced walking just so you could walk me down the aisle at my wedding.
