On April 24, 2017, Steve died peacefully at his residence in Loudoun County, Va. He was born in 1965 in Richmond, Virginia and was married to Jeannine and had four children (Stephanie, Sasha, Connor and Sienna), all of whom he loved dearly. Jeannine was an extraordinary spouse in his battle against cancer. He also is survived by his parents Patricia and Richard Hankinson of Vienna, Va., and a brother, Todd and wife Candace of North Carolina and a sister Kristine Dollard and husband Ben in California. He was close to his sister-in-law Stella who was also of great help during his illness. He has eight nieces and nephews. 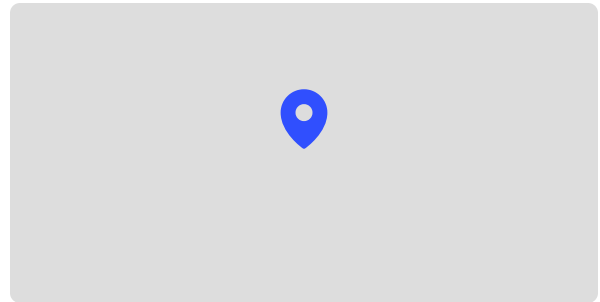

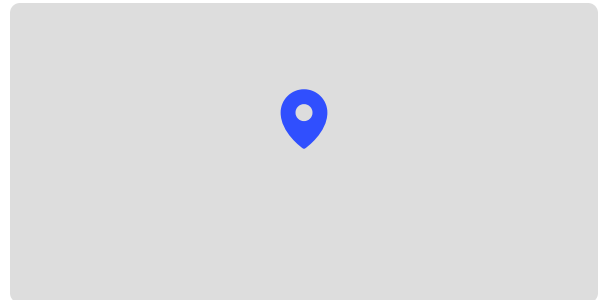

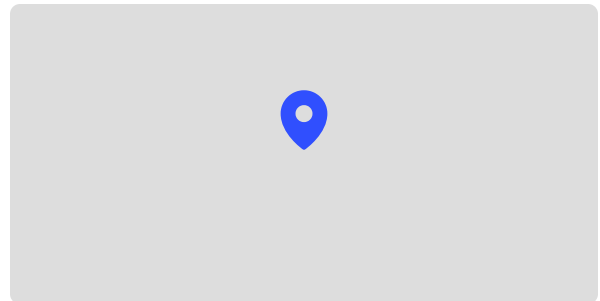
