Donald Lester Price, Sr., 65, of Manassas, Virginia went home to be with his Lord on Sunday, May 6, 2012 in Manassas.

Mr. Price was born July 29, 1946 in Abingdon, VA to the late James and Adeana (Wyatt) Price. As a young man he began his career in funeral service with Farris Funeral Home in Abingdon. After graduating from Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science, he worked with Hoy Funeral Home in Blacksburg, VA and then purchased Sanford-Price Funeral Home in Montross, VA.

Mr. Price was in Montross for several years before moving to Manassas, VA in 1984 to open Lee Funeral Home. He co-owned and operated Lee Funeral Home for many years before starting Price Funeral Home in Manassas in 1994. Mr. Price served with Loudoun Funeral Chapel in Leesburg during recent years as well as Hall Funeral Home in Purcellville.

Mr. Price demonstrated great compassion toward families in their time of need. He will be remembered as a loving father and grandfather and a caring servant of bereaved families.
