Reginald Berry Evans, Sr. of Leesburg, Virginia was born on February 23, 1949 in Middleburg, Virginia. He passed away at INOVA Loudoun Hospital on Thursday, November 16, 2017 after a short illness.

He attended Loudoun County public schools, including Douglass High School and Loudoun County High School. He was an honors student and standout on the basketball court. As a senior, he led LCHS to its first District championship in 1967.

In 1972, he became a member of the Leesburg Police Department, making him the first black policeman on the town's force. He ended his police career as a Sergeant in 1980.

He retired from the U.S. Postal Service in 2007. In 2016, he was inducted into the Loudoun County High School Athletic Hall of Fame.

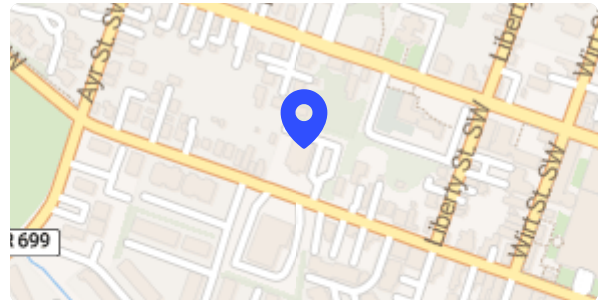
