ROBERT EDWIN "POP" DONOHOE, 97, a lifelong resident of Loudoun County, VA died on Monday May 21st 2012 in Leesburg.

Mr. Donohoe was born February 20th 1915 in Loudoun County to the late William E. and Carrie Compher Donohoe. Two children, John C. Donohoe, Dianne Rhodes and four siblings, Marvin, Lewis, Fannie and John predeceased him and in 1995 his wife Edna C. Donohoe also predeceased him.

Mr. Donohoe was a hardworking man that worked into his early 80's. He worked on the family farm until the 1960's when he pursued work with McCann Plumbing which became F&L Plumbing.

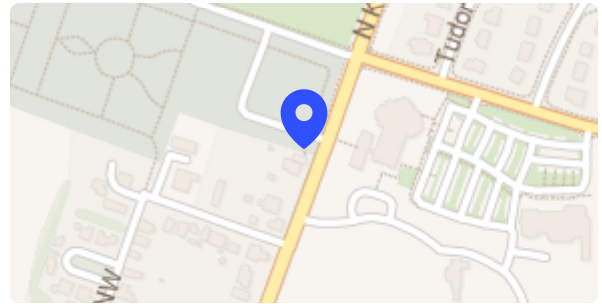
