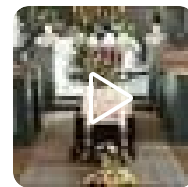

I will always remember Nannie. She was my neighbor as a child and I loved her like another grandmother. I know she is in a better place now and will be smiling as usual down on everyone.

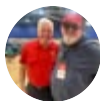

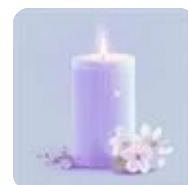

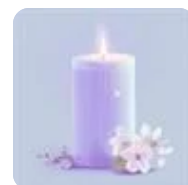
