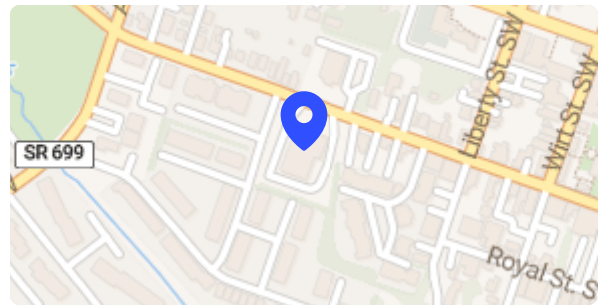

I love you more than you know. You have always been there for me, and I wish I could have been there for you today to say this in person. 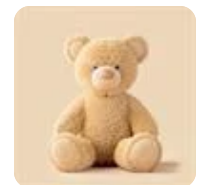
