BERNARD J.HABERLEIN, 80, died on June 15th 2012 at his home in Sterling, Virginia. He was born October 24th 1931 in Kansas City, KS to the late Leonard C. and Mary Phillips Haberlein.

Mr. Haberlein served as the director at Graydon Manor Children's Psychiatric Hospital in Leesburg, retiring in 2010.
