Interment will be in Calverton National Cemetery in Calverton, NY. Please share condolences with the family www.LoudounFuneralChapel.com




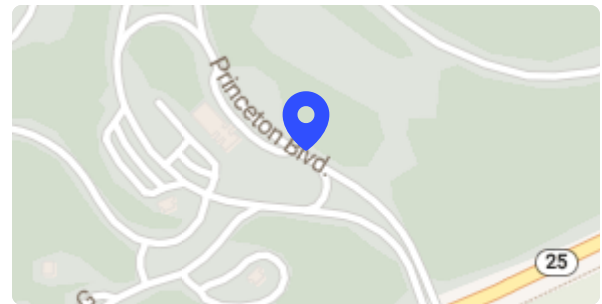
