Mrs. Orr was born November 17, 1934 to Harry Frank Mough and Leona Jean Mough of Armbrust, Pennsylvania, died on July 15, 2019 at Lansdowne Inova Hospital surrounded by her children Kim Truxel of Leesburg, Virginia and Jim Truxel of Purcellville, Virginia.

Mrs. Orr was an active member at Haymarket Chapter #123 of the Order of the Eastern Star, having served in the Eastern Star organization for over 50 years. She was a registered LPN working in the labor and delivery and pediatrics departments at Loudoun Memorial Hospital for 8 years. Mrs. Orr was one of the founding charter members of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Leesburg.

Dearest Kim and Jim, Johnny Moore sent me your email about your precious mother's death. I am so very sorry and you and your family have my deepest sympathy. I didn't see your mother often- only when I visited my cousins. Texas and Virginia are so far apart and my trips aren't as often as they once were. I believe the last time we saw each other was at my Aunt Frances' funeral. Pauline and I got along beautifully and I always enjoyed being with her. I'm so happy she married my Uncle Bobby so I could call her "Aunt, however, I always felt that we were also very good friends. My mother, Eleanor "Boo" Orr Thomson, was the eldest child of Dr. William Clayton Orr and his wife, Page Dunn Orr, and Bobby, Dr. Robert Alden Orr, was the youngest of their 7 children. I know your darling mother is gone from your view, however, she will always be with you, as she lives in your heart. My mother died in 1984 and my father died in 1977 and I believe they are with me every single day in spirit, just as I believe your mother is with you. I am so sorry we didn't keep in closer touch- it will always be my loss and regret. She was such a dear, dear lady and I loved her.
