**P**eggy Ann (Tribby) Hawks, 87, went to her heavenly home on Thursday, September 10, 2020 at Baptist Health Floyd in New Albany, Indiana. Although her journey ended in Indiana Peggy had many homes throughout her life. Greenville, Indiana was her final home in order to spend more time with her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. However, she truly called Leesburg, VA and Cantonment, Florida her hometowns as well.

Peggy was born March 22, 1933 in Lincoln, Virginia, the daughter of Harry and Theresa Tribby. She met and married a sailor, Oda Hawks, and moved away in 1951. After marrying Oda, Peggy moved to Norfolk, Va. her first move as she followed Oda through his Naval career. Her travels included many islands in the Pacific, Guam, the Philippines, Hawaii, Japan and throughout the states. She was a true military spouse supporting her family during his 30 year career. 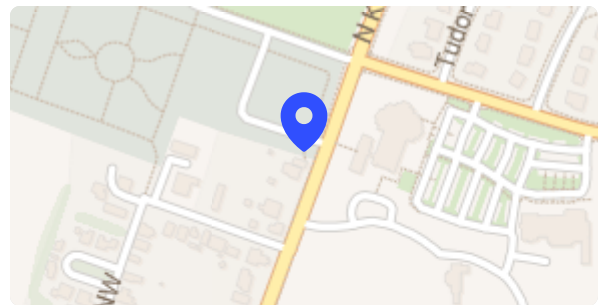
