**J**ohn M McCann, of Leesburg, passed away unexpectedly on September 15, 2020, surrounded by his loving family.

In recent years, John had worked with his wife for C-Lutions, Inc., the company they founded in 1995. He developed software and business management processes for the US Navy. Prior to 1995, he worked for Legent Corporation (formerly Morino Associates), having started Morino's technical operations in Europe.

John is survived by his wife of 30 years, Candyce; his sons Patrick and his fiancée Cynthia, of Jersey City NJ; Sean and his wife Elizabeth, of Aldie VA; and a daughter, Elizabeth, of Fairfax. 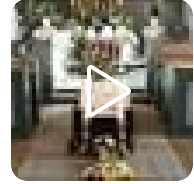
