Belinda K. "B.K." Lattimer, age 64, passed away on Wednesday, June 9, 2021 at Inova Loudoun Hospital in Leesburg, VA.

For the last 11 years, B.K. made her home in Ashburn and Falls Church, Virginia, with her husband of 25 years, Joseph Lattimer. She was born in Sylacauga, Alabama and, throughout her life, made homes in Tennessee, North Carolina and Virginia.
