**M**r. Donald Willard Trenary age 55 of Purcellville, VA, passed away suddenly on Monday, October 22, 2012.

Don was born on December 27, 1956 in Arlington, VA. He was a son of the late Willard Frederick Trenary and Mrs. Mildred Irene Runyan Trenary of Purcellville, VA. Don grew up in Arlington and received his Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from the University of Richmond.

He was employed as a Software Programmer for the County of Loudoun.

Donald was very active in his local community. He coached Little League Baseball, and was a Boy Scout leader. He founded the Cub Scout troop in Lincoln, VA. He was also instrumental in organizing the Odyssey of the Mind program at Loudoun Valley High School with his son. He was an active member of the Purcellville business community and was a man with a strong sense of civic awareness and obligation.

In addition to his mom, Donald leaves to cherish his memory his wife Jane Ellis Trenary of Purcellville, his son Jonathan Ryan Trenary of Purcellville, VA, and his nephew Benjamin Parr of TX.
