Rev. Melvin Douglas Satterwhite Sr., 82, of Sterling, Virginia, passed away peacefully into the arms of Jesus on May 13th, 2022.

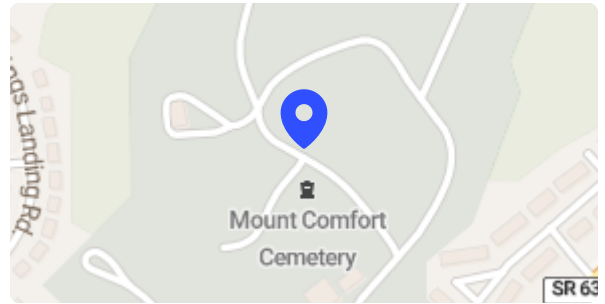

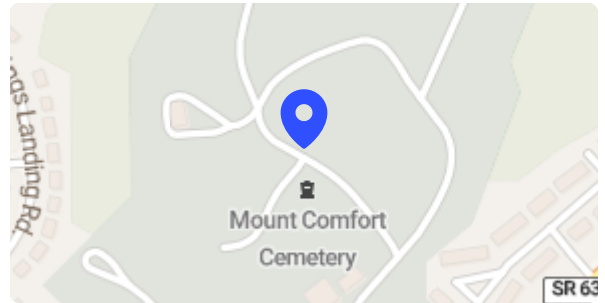
