**M**iss Sara Symons, age 58, passed away at her home on Sunday, November 11, 2012 in the care of Hospice.

Sara was born December 16, 1953, in Montevideo, Uruguay, the daughter of Richard and Helen Symons. Miss Symons received her BA in English from Mary Baldwin College and her Masters in Administrative and Supervision Pre-K to 12 from the University of Virginia. She taught first at Wilson Memorial High School in Staunton, VA and subsequently in the Loudoun County Public School system as both English and Spanish Teacher. She was a devoted and much loved teacher at Sterling MS, Blue Ridge MS, and Tuscarora HS.

Sara is survived by her brother Thomas L. Symons and sister-in-law Susan formerly of Bluemont VA, her uncle John M. Dandois of Athens TX, her uncle Dave Symons of Rich Hill, MO, and nephews Thomas L.
