Lorine Evelyn Bryant, 59, of Broadlands, VA passed away in the early morning hours of November 10, 2022, at home in the company of her family.

Lorine was born at Bergstrom Air Force Base near Austin, TX to Richard and Karen Bryant. Being a family of service Lorine moved many times with stops in Virginia, New York, Connecticut, California, and returning to Texas. She graduated from Thomas C. Clark High School in San Antonio and attended college at University of Texas, San Antonio, and the University of London.

Lorine's professional life included teaching, insurance, recruiting, and program analysis. However, her passion was helping people. She served as a Daisy, Brownie, and Girl Scout troop leader as well as volunteering with the local swim team, Broadlands Live, and many school events.
