Mrs. Helene Theresia Bridges of Leesburg, VA passed away on Friday, November 23, 2012 at Capital Caring Hospice in Arlington, surrounded by loved ones.

Helene was born on March 15, 1926 in Vienna, Austria. She was a daughter of the late Viktor Kasperger and the late Anna Gruen Kasperger.

Helene worked as a Technician for Hazelton Laboratory until retiring in 1988. She was predeceased by her husband of 60 years, Quincy Thomas Bridges, in 2008.



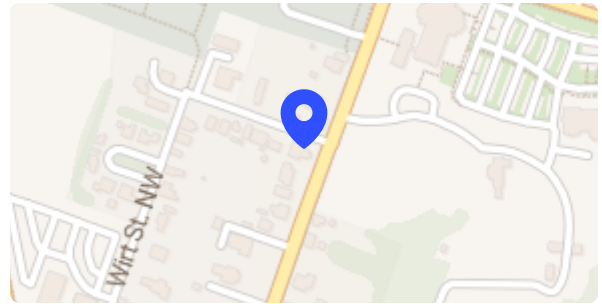

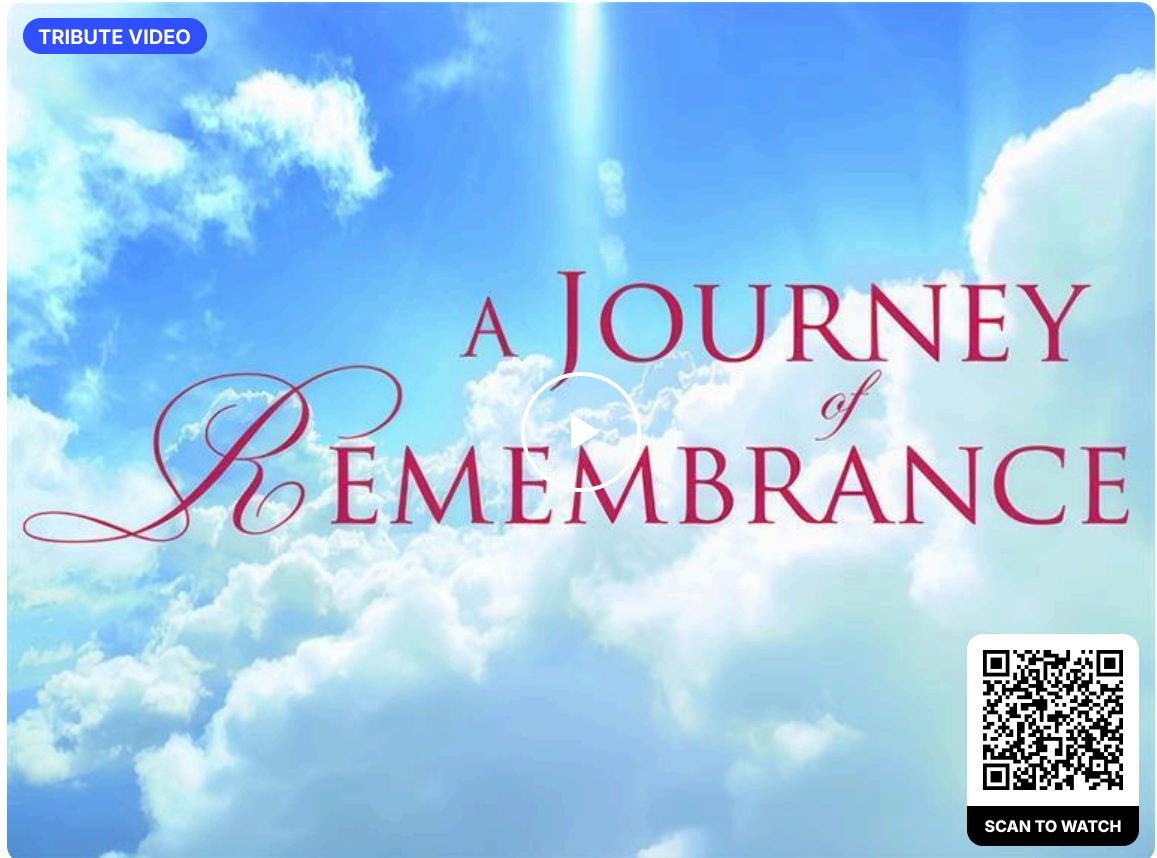
