Oda Ellis Hawks, 92, went to his heavenly home on Tuesday, December 7, 2022 at Guerin Woods in Georgetown, Indiana. Although his journey ended in Indiana, Oda had many homes throughout his life. Greenville, Indiana was his final home in order to spend time with his children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. However, he truly called Leesburg, VA and Cantonment, FL his hometowns as well.

Oda was born November 3, 1930 in Woodlawn, VA, the son of Harvey and Myrtle Hawks. He met and married the love of his life, Peggy (Tribby) Hawks in Lincoln, VA. After marrying Peggy, they made their home in Norfolk, VA. Oda's first move through his long Naval career. 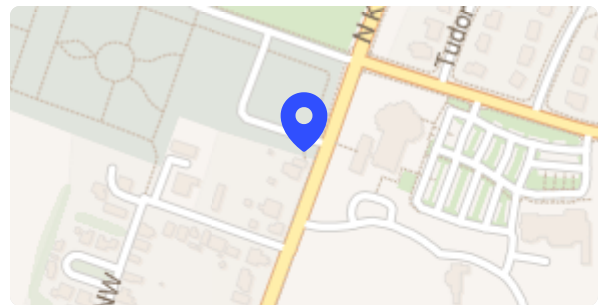
