# Lawrence Randolph Marvin

**L**AURENCE RANDOLPH MARVIN, 57, of Ashburn died suddenly at home on Monday, November 26th 2012. Mr. Marvin was born April 8th 1955 in Fresno, California. 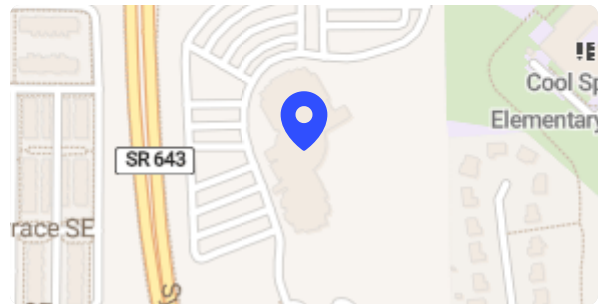
