Dean J. Rauer of Aldie, Virginia passed away at his home on April 10, 2023. He was born in North Salem, Linn County, Missouri on January 13, 1933. Dean married Barbara Elam on August 13, 1951 at the Ethel Presbyterian Church. Dean served in the U.S. Army from May, 1953 to May, 1955.

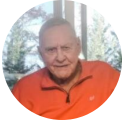
