There will be a simple grave side service performed, but no dates have been set. Family request instead of flowers that folks maybe make a small donation to a worthy charity of their choice.




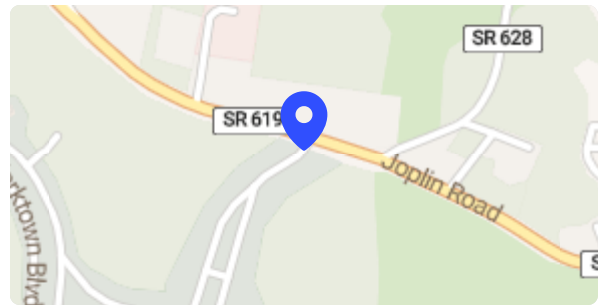
