Born on October 21, 1940, in Martinsburg, West Virginia, he passed away on November 30, 2023 at his home in Leesburg, Virginia.

Bill or Chap, as he was affectionately known, began his life journey in the town of Martinsburg, West Virginia. In 1965, he married Paige, creating a bond that endured the test of time. Their union was a testament to love, commitment, and partnership, and Paige survives him, cherishing the memories they built together over the years. Bill is survived by his brother Wayne Chapman of Martinsburg, WVA. 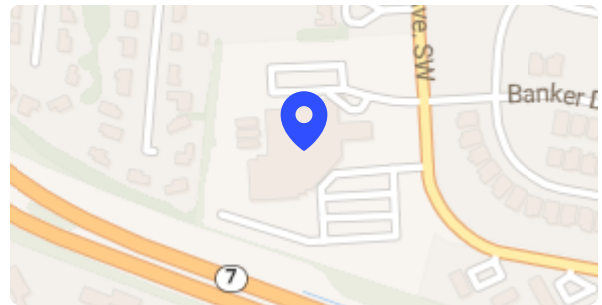
