Retired SFC Richard Gaylord Whaley passed away on Tuesday, April 9, 2024, after a short illness. He was Bigger than life, full of love, kind and generous. He will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.

Richard was born in Nutter Fort, WV on September 3, 1944 to James Oris Whaley, Sr. and Nellie Virginia Smith. Richard joined the United States Army in 1961 at the ripe old age of 16. He has always regarded his military service as the second best decision he's ever made. Not only did the US Army afford him the ability to travel and see the world, it allowed him to gain a lifetime of experiences, a treasure trove of stories and life-long friends who are more like Family; and it led him to the L♥VE of his life, Florentina Mariano! 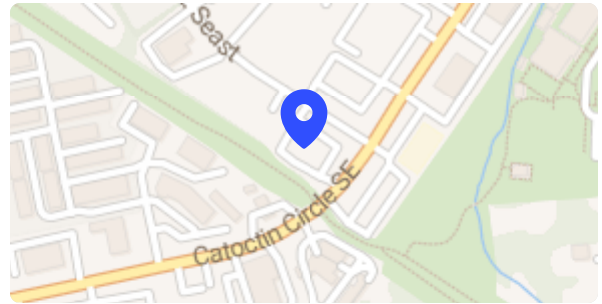

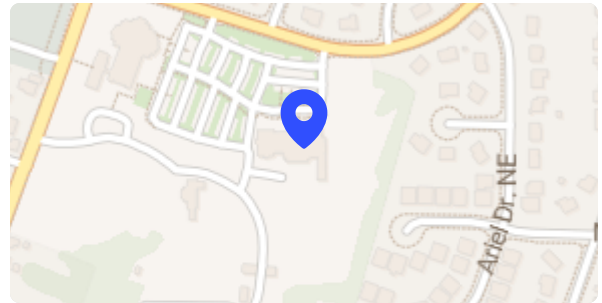

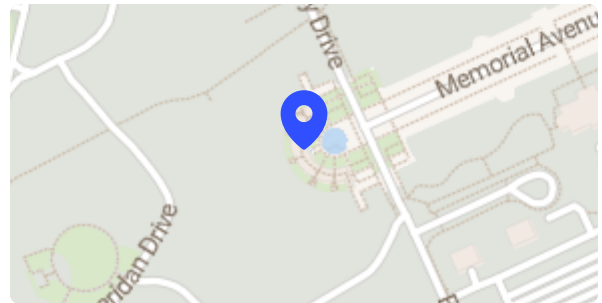
