She was a 1984 graduate of Franklin Regional High School in Murrysville, PA where she was a swimmer and a clarinet player. In 1988, Cheryl earned a bachelor's degree in business accounting from the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown and was a founding member of the Alpha Sigma Alpha sorority.

Cheryl was the devoted mother of Kylie Fleming and Kayla Fleming, who were the light of her life. She loved to support her children in anything they wanted to do including soccer, bowling, and moving around the country when they became adults. Cheryl equally loved her “furry children,” Morgan and Deena. Both dogs were adopted from Save The Tails LLC, where she also volunteered for adoption events.
