Clara Judy Huffman, 86, of Lansdowne, Virginia, passed away on Thursday, December 18, 2025.

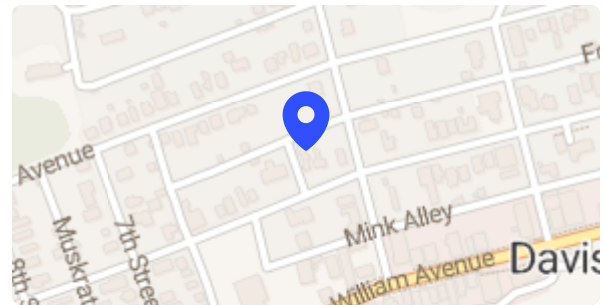
